

Humanities Media Fellowship, 2017-2018

Position Description

The Humanities Media Fellowship is a paid position that offers an opportunity for an undergraduate student at the University of Pittsburgh to plan, produce, and promote media projects that bring humanities-related projects to a broader audience. These projects will build on the success of the Being Human podcast, which features interviews with visitors to Pitt who work in the humanities. The interviews are currently available on Soundcloud (here: <https://soundcloud.com/humanities-pitt>) and iTunes.

The fellow will be expected to record and produce interviews in the Being Human series and also to produce their own content, which will be developed in consultation with the Humanities Center and WPTS. The position will provide a stipend of \$300 per month from September, 2017 through April, 2018, with the possibility of working summer months (May-August, 2018). New and creative ways to produce content and engage audiences are encouraged.

The ideal candidate will have a strong interest in the humanities, some audio editing experience, and a desire to create a broader audience for the kind of thinking that takes place in humanities departments at Pitt (a full list of humanities departments is available here: www.humcenter.pitt.edu).
